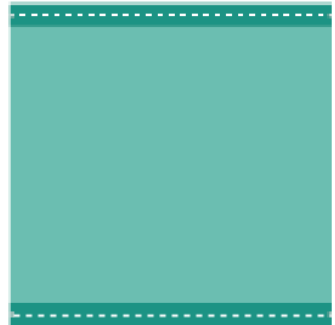


How to sew a face mask at home



01 Take a piece of 100% pure cotton fabric and sterilize it properly for your safety. Cut the fabric in approximately 20x20 cm size

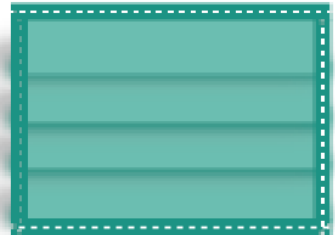


02 Now fold the upper and lower sides of the fabric to 1.5-2 cm and sew them both horizontally so that the folds become permanent.

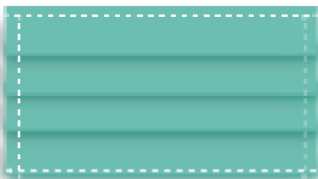

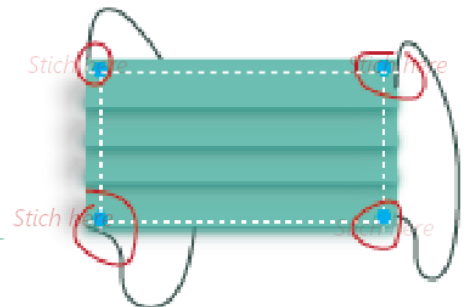
03 Now, make the even and larger folds of about 3cm in the remaining fabric from top to bottom.



04 Iron these folds so that they stay in place. Do not sew them horizontally as you did in step 3 because these folds would cover the area from your nose to chin and we would want it to remain adjustable according to our needs.



05 Now, sew the fabric vertically on the left and right sides so that the larger folds that you made in step 4 remain intact.



06 Cut the elastic in two equal pieces. Hold one piece of the elastic and sew its one side on the top left corner of the fabric. Sew the other side of this piece of elastic on the bottom left corner of the fabric. Repeat the same step for the other side and your mask will be ready to use.
